The 8 assessment fee shall be remitted on or before thirty days after the close of each 9 calendar quarter and shall be submitted with a report, on forms prescribed by the 10 secretary of the Department of Revenue, showing the gross trip fares that originated 11 in the state during the reporting quarter. (2) Funds received by the Department of Revenue in the form of assessment fees 12 13 authorized in Subsection shall be deposited immediately upon receipt into the state 14 treasury. After compliance with the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) of the 15 Constitution of Louisiana relative to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund, an 16 amount equal to that deposited as required by this Subsection shall be credited to the department and shall be used solely for the expenses of the operations of the 17 department in regulating transportation network companies, and only in the amounts 18 19 appropriated by the legislature."

the same manner."
