1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" insert "R.S. 37:1178, 1184,"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 4, after "Nutrition" and before ";" insert "and the Louisiana Board of
5 Pharmacy; to provide with respect to per diem for certain board members"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, between lines 6 and 7, insert:

8 "Section 1. R.S. 37:1178 and 1184 are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §1178. Compensation of board members

10 A. ~~In accordance with the fee schedule provided in R.S. 37:1184, members~~ Members
11 of the board shall receive a per diem of \$75 per day.

12 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 39:231, the members of the board may be
13 reimbursed for actual and reasonable expenses approved by the board in connection
14 therewith while attending regular or called board meetings or attending to official business
15 of the board.

26 A. (1) The board shall establish a reasonable fee schedule for applications, the issuance and
 27 renewal of all credentials issued by the board, and for any other administrative function
 28 provided for in this Chapter. The fee schedule shall be established and payable by rule
 29 adopted in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, R.S. 49:950 et seq. The
 30 receipts from the payment of the fees shall be used to carry out the purposes of this Chapter.
 31 The fee schedule may be modified from time to time by rule as deemed necessary by the
 32 board.

33 (2) In addition to any other fees in the fee schedule, the board is authorized to increase the
 34 following fees only to the maximum identified amounts:

- 35 (a) Three hundred dollars for the pharmacist license application.
- 36 (b) One hundred fifty dollars for the annual renewal of a pharmacist license.
- 37 (c) One hundred dollars for the pharmacy technician certificate application.
- 38 (d) Seventy five dollars for the annual renewal of a pharmacy technician certificate.
- 39 (e) Two hundred fifty dollars for the pharmacy permit application.
- 40 (f) One hundred fifty dollars for the annual renewal of a pharmacy permit.

41 B. The fees established pursuant to this Section shall be paid to the board. The board shall
 42 retain all fees and other monies received by it. The funds may be expended by the board
 43 without appropriation for the cost of administration and other expenses. Any funds
 44 remaining unexpended and unencumbered at the end of each fiscal year shall be retained by
 45 the board for expenditure in succeeding years and no part thereof shall revert to the state
 46 general fund."

51 AMENDMENT NO. 5

52 On page 3, after line 11, insert the following:

2 August 1, 2016."
