12 AMENDMENT NO. 18

13 On page 3, after line 18, insert the following:

14 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
15 or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
16 without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
17 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
18 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
