line 5, delete "cards in compliance with"

9 On page 1, line 6, after "REAL ID Act" insert "for special identification cards; to prohibit
10 the issuance of driver's licenses in compliance with the REAL ID Act of 2005;"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 20 in their entirety, delete page 2 in its entirety, and on 13 page 3, delete lines 1 through 11 in their entirety and insert the following:

"Section 1. R.S. 32:410(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
32:410(A)(3)(a)(x), (E), and (F) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
§410. Form of license; photograph, signature of licensee, anatomical gift statement,
declaration of life-sustaining procedures, and additional information on
license
A.(1) Every application for a driver's license and the license issued as a
result of such application shall contain the photograph of the applicant or licensee,
as the case may be. However, no driver's license issued as a result of such
application shall be compliant with the standards of the REAL ID Act of 2005, P.L.
109-13, and federal rules adopted pursuant thereto. At the time of renewal of a
license, the expired or expiring license shall be surrendered to the office of motor
vehicles of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.
* * *
(3)(a) Every license issued shall bear thereon:
* * *
(x) An indication that such license is not in compliance with the REAL ID
Act of 2005, P.L. 109-13.
* * *
E. The department shall not copy, scan, maintain, or share personal
identifying source documents or biometrics obtained from any person in the process
of applying for the issuance or renewal of a driver's license.
F.(1) Any personal identifying source documents or photographs of persons
obtained by the department or a contractor in the process of a person applying for or
renewing a driver's license between July 7, 2008 and the effective date of the Act
which originated as House Bill 702 of the 2016 Regular Session that were not

1	required by state law to be captured by the department or a contractor as of July 7,
2	2008 shall be disposed of as follows:
3	(a) Personal identifying source documents shall be removed and purged from
4	department and contractor databases and systems.
5	(b) All photographs of persons obtained by the department prior to 2012
6	which are in the possession of a contractor shall be purged from the database or
7	system of that contractor.
8	(2) Any photographs of a person captured in the process of a person applying
9	for or renewing a driver's license between July 7, 2008 and the effective date of the
10	Act which originated as House Bill 702 of the 2016 Regular Session may be retained
11	by the department; however, any such photographs shall be removed and purged
12	from all databases and systems of any contractor.
13	(3) The department shall notify, in writing, any person who has personal
14	identifying source documents or photographs disposed of or retained pursuant to this
15	Subsection of what was disposed of or retained by the department or a contractor.
16	(4) As used in this Subsection, the following terms shall mean and include:
17	(a) "Contractor" shall mean and include any contractor of the department or
18	any affiliate or subsidiary of such contractor and any subcontractor of such
19	contractor or any affiliate or subsidiary of such subcontractor.
20	(b) "Personal identifying source documents" shall mean and include any
21	document provided by any person to prove his identity or residence. It shall include
22	all copies, scans, or digital images of such documents.
23	(c) "Photographs" shall mean and include any captured image, digital or
24	otherwise, of a person's face. It shall include all copies, scans, or digital images of
25	such image."
