Amendments proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to Original House Bill No. 820
by Representative Walters

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, change "R.S. 40:2403(B)(1)(introductory paragraph)" to "R.S.
3 40:2403(B)(1)(introductory paragraph) and 2404.2(C)(1)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 6, after "commission;" and before "and" insert "

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 8, change "R.S. 40:2403(B)(1)(introductory paragraph) is" to "R.S.
8 40:2403(B)(1)(introductory paragraph) and 2404.2(C)(1) are"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, delete lines 16 and 17 in their entirety and insert the following:

11 "(g) Three members, one from Caddo Parish, one member from East Baton
12 Rouge Parish, and one member from Orleans Parish, each of whom shall be
13 appointed by the governor and shall also be a community leader or an academic
14 expert with prior law enforcement experience or study within the law enforcement
15 discipline from a university or law school."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 1, after line 18, add the following:

18 "§2404.2. Minimum training requirements; basic curriculum; annual training

19 * * *

20 C.(1)(a) No later than January 1, 2018, the council shall develop and
21 implement curriculum for de-escalation, bias policing recognition, sudden in-custody
22 death, and crisis intervention training, which shall include training for law
23 enforcement interaction with persons with mental illness and persons with
24 developmental disabilities, for peace officers that consists of classroom or internet
25 instruction, or both.

26 (b) Beginning January 1, 2025, each municipal police department in a
27 municipality with a population over one hundred fifty thousand shall complete this
28 training on a quarterly basis. Each municipal police department shall report
29 completion of the required training to the council.
