9 On page 1, line 15, following "(c)(i)" delete the remainder of line 15 and on page 1, line 16
10 at the beginning of line 16 delete "Orleans and Ouachita, when" and insert "When"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 2, following line 1 insert

13 " * * *

14 **(8) As it relates to the parishes of East Baton Rouge, Jefferson, Orleans, and Ouachita,**
15 **the following shall apply:**

17 **(a) When a patient is transferred from another parish pursuant to an**
18 **emergency certificate, a second physician's emergency certificate when**
19 **appropriate, shall be executed by a physician at the admitting facility.**

20 **(b) The coroner shall be notified immediately following the execution of the**
21 **second emergency certificate and shall conduct an independent examination**
22 **within seventy-two hours as provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, in**
23 **the manner provided in accordance with Subparagraph (G)(7)(a) of this**
24 **Section.**

25 **(c) Nothing herein shall be construed to authorize a period of commitment to**
26 **exceed fifteen days from the date and time the initial emergency certificate**
27 **was executed in the parish of origin.**
