Except as otherwise required by law or court order, a pleading, motion, or other document filed or recorded with the clerk of court that includes a social security number, taxpayer-identification number, financial account number, birth date, or the name of a person known to be a minor, shall specify only:  (1) the last four digits of the social security number, taxpayer identification number, or financial account number.  (2) the year of the person's birth.  (3) the initials of the minor.  B. The failure to comply with the provisions of this Article shall not affect the validity of what is filed or recorded, or provide a basis for the clerk of court to refuse to accept it.  C. The clerk of court shall not be liable for loss or damages resulting from the filing or recording of a pleading, motion or other document that fails
35	to comply with the provisions of this Article."
