

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 194 (HB 154)**

**2018 Regular Session**

**Magee**

Existing law authorizes the Dept. of Children and Family Services (DCFS) to obtain certain information for the purposes of child support enforcement. Further, with respect to child support enforcement, authorizes DCFS to order DNA testing and to subpoena additional information from sources including marriage, birth, and divorce records; state and local tax and revenue records; real and titled property records; employment security records; corrections records; occupational and professional license records; public assistance program records; records of the office of motor vehicles; and records of public utilities, cable television companies, and cellular telephone companies.

New law retains existing law and adds thereto an authorization for DCFS to access records of electronic communications and Internet service providers in carrying out child support enforcement functions.

Effective August 1, 2018.
