Provides relative to the task force on coordination of Medicaid fraud detection and prevention initiatives

Present law provides for an interagency task force with the purpose of 1) studying and evaluating the laws, rules, policies and processes by which the state implements Medicaid fraud detection and prevention efforts, and 2) identify and recommend opportunities for improving coordination of Medicaid fraud detection/prevention initiatives, and 3) make reports to the governor and the legislature relative to recommendations.

Proposed law extends the sunset date of the task force 1 more year, from August 1, 2018 to August 1, 2019.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The task force on coordination of Medicaid fraud detection and prevention sunsets August 1, 2018. This measure reauthorizes the task force for 1 year (from August 1, 2018 to August 1, 2019). Legislative per diem costs paid to two legislators serving on the task force are anticipated to be negligible in FY 19. The legislative per diem rate is \$177/day (\$354 for two members per meeting).
