Abstract: Provides relative to the Early Childhood Care and Education Commission.

Present law provides for the Early Childhood Care and Education Commission to study and make recommendations relative to early childhood care and education. Proposed law revises present law as follows:

- (1) Present law provides for 41 members. Proposed law increases the membership from 41 to 45.
- (2) Proposed law provides for four-year terms but specifies that terms of members appointed by elected officials shall not extend beyond the term of the appointing authority.
- (3) Present law provides that a majority of the commission members constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business. Proposed law removes present law.
- (4) Proposed law adds that the affirmative vote of those present and voting is required for any action of the commission.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill:

1. Increase membership from 41 to 45 instead of 43.
2. Remove present law providing that a majority of commission members constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business.
3. Remove proposed law relative to the establishment of an executive committee.
