

New law provides for the design and creation of the "La. Golf Association" special prestige license plate provided there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants.

New law requires that the license plate be issued, upon application, to any citizen of La. in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

New law requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to collect a \$25 royalty fee, as well as a handling fee of \$3.50 for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

New law provides that monies collected by the department and forwarded to the La. Golf Association, or its successor organization, be used for the growth of game initiatives, including but not limited to junior golf in La.

Effective August 1, 2014.
