**Abstract:** Provides relative to the parcel fee that is authorized for the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District in New Orleans.

Present law creates the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District in New Orleans to promote and encourage the beautification, security, and overall betterment of the district.

Present law authorizes the governing authority of New Orleans, subject to voter approval to impose a parcel fee within the district to provide funds for the district. Provides that the fee shall be a flat fee per improved parcel of land not to exceed \$200 per year per parcel.

Proposed law increases the maximum fee to \$300 per parcel per year.

Present law provides for expiration of the initial fee on Dec. 31, 2015. Authorizes renewal of the fee, subject to voter approval, for a term not to exceed eight years.

Proposed law provides for an eight-year initial term of the parcel fee; otherwise retains present law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
