Existing law provides for modification of dispositions while a child is in the custody of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections. Prior law required motions filed by DPS&C seeking to make the conditions of the disposition less restrictive to be tried contradictorily against the district attorney.

New law changes prior law to require motions filed by DPS&C seeking the release of the child from its custody to be tried contradictorily.

Effective August 1, 2018.
