Adams (HB 544) Act No. 74

<u>Prior law</u> provided that fire prevention interference is the intentional performance of any of the following acts:

- (1) Defacing or destroying fire warning notices or posters.
- (2) Injuring, destroying, removing, or in any manner interfering with the use of any tools, equipment, towers, buildings, or telephone lines used in the detection, reporting, or suppression of fire.

<u>New law</u> retains the provisions of <u>prior law</u> and adds life safety systems to the definition of the crime and additionally adds the following two elements:

- (1) Obstructing exits, impeding egress, or exceeding the capacity or posted occupant load of a building or structure.
- (2) Unauthorized use or proximate display as defined in R.S. 51:650(9), of fireworks in a building or structure.

Effective Aug. 1, 2014.
