

Existing law requires a person applying for a commercial driver's license to provide a current medical report on a form approved by the office of motor vehicles. The applicant is required to submit a valid medical report upon each renewal and carry a current medical certificate on his person at all times when driving a commercial motor vehicle.

New law modifies existing law by requiring a person applying for a commercial driver's license provide a current medical examiner's certificate on a form approved by the office of motor vehicles. Requires the applicant submit a valid medical examiner's certificate upon each renewal and carry a current medical examiner's certificate on his person at all times when driving a commercial motor vehicle.
