

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 275 (HB 744)**

**2018 Regular Session**

**Leger**

Existing law authorizes the governor to declare a state of emergency or disaster by executive order or proclamation.

New law provides that a district court or a court of limited jurisdiction may sign orders and judgments while outside of its territorial jurisdiction during an emergency or disaster declared as such by the governor pursuant to existing law if the emergency or disaster prevents the court from operating in its own jurisdiction. New law further requires that the court shall indicate the location where the order or judgment was signed.

Effective August 1, 2018.
