Existing law provides for the crime of malfeasance in office.

Prior law provided for imprisonment for not more than five years with or without hard labor or a fine of not more than \$5,000, or both for whoever committed the crime of malfeasance in office.

New law changes the penalty of imprisonment, to be served with or without hard labor, from a maximum of five years to 10 years.

Effective August 1, 2024.
