**Abstract:** Increases the number of members of a parish executive committee of the Democratic Party in Caddo Parish.

Present law provides that in each parish, the parish executive committee of a recognized political party shall be composed of five members-at-large and as many members as there are members of the parish governing authority. The members-at-large shall be elected from the entire parish, while the additional members shall be elected, one each, from the districts or wards from which the members of the parish governing authority are elected.

Present law provides exceptions for the parish executive committees of recognized political parties in Orleans, Jefferson, and Lafayette parishes.

Proposed law adds an exception for the parish executive committee of the Democratic Party in Caddo Parish that it shall be composed of one member elected from each parish commission district and 12 members elected at large from the parish.

### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to the original bill:

1. Restricts the proposed law exception so that it applies only to the parish executive committee of the Democratic Party in Caddo Parish, rather than any recognized political party in Caddo Parish.

### The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Explicitly require that all other recognized political parties in Caddo Parish comply with present law.
