Authorizes inclusion of notice on driver's license of health condition that may impede ability to communicate with a peace officer. (8/1/20)

Under present law, an applicant for a driver's license who needs accommodation shall have a designation "needs accommodation" on the applicant's driver's license. Proposed law expands present law to include any health condition that may impede an applicant's ability to communicate with a peace officer as a medical reason to have a designation of "needs accommodation".

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law allows persons with any health condition that may impede their ability to communicate with a peace officer to have a "needs accommodation" designation on their driver's license. This adjustment adds a new class to those currently eligible to receive the "needs accommodation" designation on a driver's license, but does not require additional programmatic or programming changes. The Department of Public Safety, Office of Motor Vehicles would require a change to the policy and procedures to incorporate the proposed legislation, which is not anticipated to impact departmental expenditures.
