The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Margaret M. Corley.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 11:446(A)(5)), relative to the La. State Employees' Retirement System (LASERS), provides a member with an initial lump-sum benefit option at the time of his retirement.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a survivor lump-sum benefit option for the surviving spouse of a judge who, at the time of his death:

- (1) Was in state service.
- (2) Was eligible to receive a retirement benefit at a rate of 100% of his average compensation.
- (3) Was eligible to select the Initial Benefit Option pursuant to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the survivor lump-sum benefit shall be calculated as if the member had retired the day preceding his death and selected the option in <u>present law</u>. Provides for the survivor to select the amount of the lump sum. Provides, however, that the lump sum selected shall not exceed 36 months of the judge's maximum allowance.
