

Proposed law provides that all data shared will include a minimum set of personally identifiable information and will be separated into personal and nonpersonal information.

Proposed law provides personal information will be used only to generate a unique identifier for each record.

Proposed law prohibits research and analysis may from being conducted on data that includes personally identifiable information.

Proposed law becomes effective only upon an appropriation by the legislature.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill

1. Specify that the Board of Regents is the entity charged with developing and maintaining LA FIRST.
2. Provide for the data sharing agreements with state agencies to be executed by LA FIRST through the Board of Regents.
3. Clarify that once access to the data has been provided to the policy center, the policy center must comply with all confidentiality, privilege, privacy, and other legal restrictions.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the engrossed bill

1. Provide proposed law shall become effective only upon an appropriation by the legislature.
