Present law provides that an employee of the parish or city school boards of this state, who is disabled while acting in his official capacity as a result of physical contact with a student while providing physical assistance to a student to prevent danger or risk of injury to the student, shall receive sick leave for a period up to 90 days without reduction in pay and without reduction in accrued sick leave days while disabled as a result of rendering such assistance.

Present law requires an employee to present a certificate from a physician certifying the disability. Present law further allows a city or parish school board to extend the sick leave period beyond 90 days.

Proposed law retains present law but changes the sick leave period from 90 days to one year.

Proposed law defines disabled pursuant to R.S. 17:1200(C).

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
