DIGEST

Dorsey-Colomb (SB 236)

Proposed law provides that, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, all bidders shall submit all bid forms required by statute or by the Louisiana Administrative Code to the governing authority of East Baton Rouge Parish prior to the opening of all bids relative to a contract for public works.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Clarifies that the bid forms to be submitted are those required by statute.
2. Removes specific reference to the attestation clause provisions in present law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the engrossed bill.

1. Deletes proposed law and instead requires that all bidders shall submit bid forms required by statute or the Louisiana Administrative Code, rather than the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, to the governing authority of East Baton Rouge Parish before the opening of all bids relative to a contract for public works.
