DIGEST

Mills (SB 396)

<u>Present law</u> provides certain mandatory minimum sentences for certain <u>present law</u> crimes.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that, notwithstanding any other provision of <u>present law</u> to the contrary, the sentencing of a defendant, other than a defendant convicted of a "crime of violence" or a "sex offense" as defined in <u>present law</u>, is at the sole discretion of the court.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that in no case can the sentence imposed exceed the maximum sentence set forth in <u>present law</u> under which the defendant was convicted.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
