2	To enact R.S. 37:1437(C)(6)(b), relative to continuing education; to provide for an
3	exemption from continuing education requirements for certain licensed real estate
4	brokers or salespersons who are sixty-five years of age or older; and to provide for
5	related matters.

Abstract: Exempts certain licensed real estate brokers or salespersons who are 65 years of age or older from continuing education requirements.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the license of an individual real estate broker or salesperson shall not be renewed unless the broker or salesperson furnishes proof of completion of 12 hours per year of continuing education.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but exempts, from the continuing education requirement, any person 65 years of age or older, who has at least 20 continuous years of experience as a licensed real estate broker or salesperson, and has not been subject to any disciplinary action by the La. Real Estate Commission in the previous five years.
