1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 15:158(A)(3), relative to the Louisiana Public Defender Board;

3 to provide with respect to the educational requirements for the juvenile justice

4 compliance officer; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 15:158(A)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §158. Juvenile justice compliance officer

8 A. The board shall employ a juvenile justice compliance officer who shall  
9 meet the following qualifications:

11 (3) Be an attorney licensed to practice law in the United States with at least  
12 three years of experience as a criminal defense attorney or in juvenile law, or possess  
13 a master's degree in public administration or a doctoral degree in any field from an  
14 accredited school or university and possess five years of progressively responsible  
15 experience conducting organizational assessments, ~~and, if~~ If licensed as an attorney  
16 in a state other than Louisiana, the juvenile justice compliance officer shall become  
17 licensed as an attorney in this state within one year of being employed by the board.
