WORKERS COMPENSATION: Provides with respect to the determination of wages for professional athletes

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 23:1021(12)(d), relative to workers' compensation; to provide 3 for the determination of the average weekly wage of a professional athlete; and to 4 provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 23:1021(12)(d) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 7 §1021. Terms defined 8 As used in this Chapter, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the 9 following terms shall be given the meaning ascribed to them in this Section: 10 11 (12)12 13 (d) Other wages. 14 (I) If the employee is employed on a unit, piecework, commission, or other 15 basis, his gross earnings from the employer for the twenty-six week period 16 immediately preceding the accident divided by the number of days the employee 17 actually worked for the employer during said the twenty-six week period and multiplied by the average number of days worked per week; however, if such an 18 19 employee has worked for the employer for less than a twenty-six week period 20 immediately preceding the accident, his gross earnings from the employer for the

1 period immediately preceding the accident divided by the number of days the 2 employee actually worked for the employer during said the period and multiplied by 3 the average number of days worked per week. (ii)(aa) If the employee is employed as a professional athlete and has signed 4 a contract for hire, is on an official club roster, and is injured during the regular 5 season, his average weekly wage shall be determined by his contract. 6 7 (bb) If the employee is employed as a professional athlete who has signed 8 a contract for hire, is not on an official club roster during the regular season, and is 9 injured during any portion of the off-season or pre-season, his average weekly wage 10 shall be calculated based on the actual off-season or pre-season wages earned at the 11 time of the injury.

Broadwater HB No. 1073

Abstract: For the purposes of workers' compensation, provides for the determination of the average weekly wage for professional athletes.

Present law defines "wages" to mean the average weekly wage at the time of the accident.

<u>Present law</u> provides guidelines for the calculation of average weekly wage for different situations including monthly wages, annual wages, hourly wages, and other wages.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the average weekly wage of a professional athlete who has a contract, is on the club roster, and is injured during the regular season, will be determined by his contract.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the average weekly wage of a professional athlete who has a contract, but is not on the club roster during the regular season and is injured during the off-season or pre-season, shall be calculated based on the actual off-season or pre-season wages earned at the time of the accident.
