BOARDS/COMMISSIONS: Provides relative to the membership of the La. Health Works Commission

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:2048.51(C)(14) and to enact R.S. 17:2048.51(C)(18) and
3 (G)(7), relative to the Louisiana Health Works Commission; to provide for
4 membership of such commission; to provide for membership of the executive
5 committee within such commission; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 17:2048.51(C)(14) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
8 17:2048.51(C)(18) and (G)(7) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §2048.51. Louisiana Health Works Commission; creation; membership;
10 compensation; staff and facilities; powers and duties; data collection and
11 reporting

13 C. The following shall serve as members of the Louisiana Health Works

Abstract: Provides relative to the membership of the La. Health Works Commission.

Present law provides that the purpose of the La. Health Works Commission is to serve as a collaborative working group to integrate and coordinate resources relative to health care workforce development within various state departments and key organizations.

Present law provides for the duties and membership of the commission.

Proposed law deletes the requirement of present law that the commission member from the Medical Education Commission also be a member of the La. State Medical Society.

Proposed law adds the president of the La. State Medical Society or his designee as a commission member.

Present law provides for the duties and membership of an executive committee of the commission. Proposed law retains present law and adds the president of the La. State Medical Society or his designee to the executive committee.
