HOLIDAYS: Designates the seventh day of August as "Purple Heart Recognition Day"

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 1:58.6, relative to state holidays; to establish "Purple Heart Recognition Day"
3 as an annual state holiday; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 1:58.6 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 §58.6. Purple Heart Recognition Day

7 The seventh day of August shall be recognized as "Purple Heart Recognition
8 Day" and shall be dedicated to the remembrance and recognition of those members
9 of the armed forces of the United States who have earned the Purple Heart Medal for
10 wounds received in combat.
