

1 Art. 740. Restrictions on subpoenas; members of the legislature and personnel

2 No subpoena or order compelling discovery shall issue to compel the
3 attendance of a member of the Louisiana Legislature, or legislative employee, except
4 in strict conformity with the ~~provisions~~ provision of R.S. 13:3667.1 and ~~3667.3~~ no
5 subpoena or order compelling discovery shall issue to compel the attendance of a
6 member or former member of the Louisiana Legislature, or legislative employee,
7 except in strict conformity with the provision of R.S. 13:3667.3. For purposes of this
8 Article, "legislative employee" means the clerk of the House of Representatives, the
9 secretary of the Senate, and employees of the House of Representatives, the Senate,
10 and the Legislative Bureau.

11 Section 3. R.S. 13:3667.3(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

12 §3667.3. Statewide elected officials, members of the legislature, legislative
13 personnel, appointed heads of state departments, compelled appearance as
14 witness in court or at administrative proceeding, hearing required

15 * * *

16 B. For purposes of this Section:

17 (1) ~~"legislative~~ Legislative employee" means the clerk of the House of
18 Representatives, the secretary of the Senate, or an employee of the House of
19 Representatives, the Senate, or the Legislative Bureau.

20 (2) "Member" means a sitting or former member of the Louisiana
21 Legislature.

23 Section 4. R.S. 49:956.1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

24 §956.1. Administrative proceedings; member of the legislature or personnel as
25 witness

26 An application for an order compelling discovery to a member or former
27 member of the legislature in his capacity as a state lawmaker, or a legislative
28 employee in his official capacity, when the legislature or either body thereof is not
29 a party to the proceeding may be made to the agency in which the action is pending,
30 but no order compelling discovery shall issue except in strict conformity with the

1 provisions of R.S. 13:3667.3(D). For the purposes of this Section "legislative
2 employee" shall mean the clerk of the House of Representatives, the secretary of the
3 Senate, or an employee of the House of Representatives, the Senate, or the
4 Legislative Bureau.
