| 14 | Court of Ville Platte, and any city court in which the population of the territorial     |
| 15 | jurisdiction is less than fifty thousand, except as otherwise specifically provided by   |
| 16 | law, the civil jurisdiction is concurrent with the district court in cases where the     |
| 17 | amount in dispute, or the value of the property involved, does not exceed fifteen        |
| 18 | thousand dollars.  |
