SCHOOLS: Requires high schools in certain parishes to keep automated external defibrillators on their premises

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1137.3(E)(2), relative to entities in possession of automated
3 external defibrillators; to require that each high school in certain parishes have an
4 automated external defibrillator on its premises; to provide for a legislative
5 declaration; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:1137.3(E)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

8 §1137.3. Persons in possession of AEDs; training, testing, and notification
9 requirements; manufacturer responsibility; possession required

13 (2)(a) Each high school that participates in interscholastic athletics shall have
14 an AED on its premises, if funding is available.

15 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph,
16 each high school in any parish with a population of more than two hundred thousand
17 and less than two hundred twenty-five thousand according to the latest federal
18 decennial census shall have an AED on its premises.

1 Section 2.(A) The legislature hereby declares that the safety of young persons and
2 the timely, effective provision of emergency medical services are public health priorities of
3 this state.

4 (B) This Act shall be known as the "Teddy Daigle and Shane Ozene Act".

Abstract: Requires each high school in any parish with a population of more than 200,000 and less than 225,000 to keep an automated external defibrillator on its premises.

Present law requires each high school that participates in interscholastic athletics to have an automated external defibrillator on its premises, if funding is available. Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law requires each high school in any parish with a population of more than 200,000 and less than 225,000 to keep an automated external defibrillator on its premises notwithstanding conditions of present law relative to participation in interscholastic athletics and funding availability.

Proposed law provides that it shall be known as the "Teddy Daigle and Shane Ozene Act".
