LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS: Changes the requirement that agencies mail a list of reports and publications to each legislator to a requirement that agencies send such list by e-mail

| 6 | Section 1. R.S. 24:772(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: |
| 7 | §772. Distribution of reports |
| 8 | A. To comply with any provision of law and any resolution requiring or |
| 9 | requesting the submission of reports to the legislature, it shall be sufficient to provide |
| 10 | one printed copy of the report to the presiding officer of each house of the |
| 11 | legislature. In addition, the agency shall send an e-mail notification which contains |
| 12 | an electronic copy of the report to the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library |
| 13 | in such an electronic format as may be determined by the Legislative Budgetary |
| 14 | Control Council. The David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library shall distribute |
| 15 | a list of such reports to the members of the legislature via e-mail and, upon the |
| 16 | request of a member, via paper copy. Additionally, each agency shall distribute a list |
| 17 | of its reports and publications to each member of the legislature by mail e-mail each |
| 18 | year. |

Abstract: Authorizes agencies to e-mail lists of reports and publications to members of the legislature.

<u>Present law</u> addresses the distribution of agency reports to the legislature. Authorizes the submission of one printed copy of a report to the presiding officer of each house as adequate compliance with any provision of law or any resolution requesting the submission of a report to the legislature. <u>Present law</u> further directs the agency to e-mail an electronic copy of the report to the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library. <u>Present law</u> also requires each agency to annually mail a list of its reports and publications to each member of the legislature. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> requires this list of reports and publications to be sent to legislators via postal mail. <u>Proposed law</u> requires sending the lists via electronic mail (e-mail).
