2	To amend and reenact R.S. $3:1413(C)(2)(a)$ and $1415(A)(6)$ and to enact R.S. $3:1415(A)(7)$ ,
3	relative to fertilizers; to provide for the regulations on the sale of fertilizers; to
4	provide for an inspection fee; to provide for due dates; to provide for a deficiency
5	assessment; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 3:1413(C)(2)(a) and 1415(A)(6) are hereby amended and reenacted
8	and R.S. 3:1415(A)(7) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§1413. Restrictions on sale of fertilizer

13	(2)(a) Payment of tonnage the inspection fee shall be on the basis of tonnage
14	reports submitted by the registrant who prior to making sales must file a statement
15	with the commission agreeing to keep such records as are necessary to accurately
16	indicate the tonnage and kind of fertilizer sold and must grant the commissioner the
17	right to examine such records for verification of the statement of tonnage. The
18	tonnage reports shall be made on forms supplied by the commissioner for supplying
19	the necessary tonnage and statistical information. The tonnage reports and
20	inspection fees shall be due and payable on the first day of July April, the first day
21	of October July, the first day of January October, and the first day of March January.
22	The minimum inspection fee due for each quarter shall be ten dollars.

1 §1415. Deficiency assessment 2 A. Whenever the commissioner determines, based on an analysis performed 3 by the state chemist, that a given lot or shipment of fertilizer is deficient in one or 4 more guaranteed plant foods, a deficiency assessment shall be assessed against the 5 guarantor in accordance with the following provisions: 6 7 (6) The minimum deficiency assessment under this Part shall be ten dollars. 8 (6) (7) All deficiency assessments assessed under this Section shall be paid 9 by the guarantor to the person who purchased the fertilizer for use, if known, within 10 thirty days of notice by the commissioner to the registrant.
