2	To amend and reenact R.S. 47:462(C), relative to motor vehicles; to authorize the use of
3	prestige license plates on certain trucks; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 47:462(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
6	§462. Trucks and trailers
7	* * *
8	C. Any truck having a gross vehicle weight of not more than ten sixteen
9	thousand pounds which is registered in the state and is not registered under the
10	International Registration Plan is eligible for any prestige license plate authorized
11	by this Part.

Abstract: Authorizes the use of prestige license plates on certain trucks.

<u>Present law</u> allows any registered truck having a gross vehicle weight of 10,000 pounds to have a prestige license plate

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the allowable weight to 16,000 pounds and provides that the truck shall not be registered under the International Registration Plan.
