**Abstract:** Prohibits the adoption or enforcement of any building code, local ordinance, or other regulation that requires a fire protection sprinkler system in one- or two- family dwellings.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the La. State Uniform Construction Code Council from adopting or enforcing any part of the International Residential Code or any other code or regulation that requires a fire protection sprinkler system in one- or two- family dwellings.

<u>Proposed law</u> further prohibits a municipality or parish from adopting or enforcing an ordinance or other regulation requiring a fire protection sprinkler system in one- or two-family dwellings.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
