RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL POL: Provides for benefits of rehired employees in the
Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 11:2220(J), relative to the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System;
3 to remove limitations on payment of benefits to retirees who are reemployed by a
4 third-party contractor.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution
7 of Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 11:2220(J) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Abstract: Repeals a required benefit suspension for retirees who are reemployed in certain positions in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System (MPERS)

Present law, relative to MPERS, requires the suspension of benefits of a retiree who becomes reemployed in certain positions within 24 months of his retirement. Provides that the suspension remains in effect for the duration of the employment or until 24 months after his retirement, whichever occurs first.

Proposed law repeals present law.
