HOUSE BILL NO. 231

RETIREMENT/CLERKS COURT: Relative to the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund, provides for retirement with 30 years of service at any age

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 11:1521(A), relative to the Clerks' of Court Retirement and
3 Relief Fund; to provide with respect to eligibility for retirement; to provide for
4 retirement upon attaining at least thirty years of service without regard to age; to
5 provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

6 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
7 as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution
8 of Louisiana.

9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

10 Section 1. R.S. 11:1521(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

11 §1521. Regular retirement benefits

12 A. A member or former member who has terminated employment shall be
13 eligible for regular retirement benefits if he has attained any of the following:

14 (1) Twelve or more years of credited service ~~he~~ and has attained the age of
15 fifty-five years or more; ~~and he has terminated his employment.~~

16 (2) Thirty or more years of credited service, without regard to age.

17 * * *

1 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governor
2 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
3 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

Abstract: Provides for retirement with 30 years of service at any age for members of the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund.

Present law provides that a member or former member of the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund shall be eligible for regular retirement benefits if he has 12 or more years of credited service and has attained the age of 55 or more.

Proposed law retains present law and adds provision allowing eligibility for regular retirement benefits with 30 or more years of credited service, without regard to age.

Effective July 1, 2010.
