| 13 | Regular Session of the Legislature, the governing authority of the city of Alexandria |
| 14 | may create, by ordinance, the position of deputy chief of police in accordance with |
| 15 | the provisions of R.S. 33:2481.4. |

| 1 | Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not |

| 4 | vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become |
