CRIME: Creates the crime of unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of law enforcement badges

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 14:112.4, relative to offenses affecting law enforcement; to create the crime
3	of unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of unauthorized
4	peace officer badges; to provide for definitions; to provide for criminal penalties; and
5	to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 14:112.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§112.4. Unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of
9	unauthorized peace officer badges
10	A. It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly or intentionally produce,
11	manufacture, distribute, or possess unauthorized peace officer badges.
12	B. For purposes of this Section:
13	(1) "Distribute" means to sell, give, transport, issue, provide, lend, deliver,
14	transfer, transmit, distribute, or disseminate.
15	(2) "Peace officer" shall include commissioned police officers, sheriffs,
16	deputy sheriffs, marshals, deputy marshals, correctional officers, constables, wildlife
17	enforcement agents, park wardens, livestock brand inspectors, forestry officers, and
18	probation and parole officers.
19	(3) "Produce or manufacture" means to develop, prepare, design, create, or
20	otherwise process.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	(4) "Unauthorized peace officer badge" means any device or emblem,
2	regardless of the material of which it is made, worn as an insignia of rank, office, or
3	membership of a peace officer in a law enforcement agency which has not been
4	expressly authorized by the law enforcement agency.
5	C.(1) Whoever violates the provisions of this Section by possessing an
6	unauthorized peace officer badge shall be fined not more than fifty dollars,
7	imprisoned for not more than ten days, or both.
8	(2) Whoever violates the provisions of this Section by distributing,
9	manufacturing, or producing an unauthorized peace officer badge upon a first
10	conviction shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars, imprisoned for not more
11	than ninety days, or both. Upon a second or subsequent conviction, the offender
12	shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars, imprisoned for not more than six
13	months, or both.

**Abstract:** Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of unauthorized peace officer badges.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly or intentionally produce, manufacture, distribute, or possess unauthorized peace officer badges.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides penalties for possession of an unauthorized peace officer badge including a fine of not more than \$50, imprisonment for not more than 10 days, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the following penalties for distributing, manufacturing, or producing an unauthorized peace officer badge:

- (1) For a first conviction A fine of not more than \$200, imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both.
- (2) For a second or subsequent conviction A fine of not more than \$1,000, imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.
