HOUSE BILL NO. 264

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

CRIME: Creates the crime of unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of law enforcement badges

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 14:112.4, relative to offenses affecting law enforcement; to create the crime
3	of unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of unauthorized
4	peace officer badges; to provide for definitions; to provide for criminal penalties; to
5	provide for exceptions; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 14:112.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	<u>§112.4.</u> Unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of
9	unauthorized peace officer badges
10	A. It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly or intentionally produce,
11	manufacture, distribute, or possess unauthorized peace officer badges.
12	B. For purposes of this Section:
13	(1) "Distribute" means to sell, give, transport, issue, provide, lend, deliver,
14	transfer, transmit, distribute, or disseminate.
15	(2) "Peace officer" shall include commissioned police officers, sheriffs,
16	deputy sheriffs, marshals, deputy marshals, correctional officers, constables, wildlife
17	enforcement agents, park wardens, livestock brand inspectors, forestry officers,
18	attorney general investigators, district attorney investigators, inspector general
19	investigators, and probation and parole officers.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	(3) "Produce or manufacture" means to develop, prepare, design, create, or
2	otherwise process.
3	(4) "Unauthorized peace officer badge" means any device or emblem,
4	regardless of the material of which it is made, worn as an insignia of rank, office, or
5	membership of a peace officer in a law enforcement agency which has not been
6	expressly authorized by the law enforcement agency.
7	C.(1) Whoever violates the provisions of this Section by possessing an
8	unauthorized peace officer badge shall be fined not more than fifty dollars,
9	imprisoned for not more than ten days, or both.
10	(2) Whoever violates the provisions of this Section by distributing,
11	manufacturing, or producing an unauthorized peace officer badge upon a first
12	conviction shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars, imprisoned for not more
13	than ninety days, or both. Upon a second or subsequent conviction, the offender
14	shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars, imprisoned for not more than six
15	months, or both.
16	D. The provisions of this Section shall not be construed to limit the
17	production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of a peace officer badge with
18	the designation "police", "marshal", "sheriff", "law enforcement", "warden", or any
19	other designation which does not designate a specific law enforcement agency by
20	name or jurisdiction and which is intended for novelty purposes.
21	E. The definition of a "peace officer" as provided for in Paragraph (B)(2) of
22	this Section, shall be strictly construed solely for the purposes of this Section and
23	shall not be construed as granting the authority to any agency not defined as a "peace
24	officer" pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 40:2402 to make arrests, perform search
25	and seizures, execute criminal warrants, prevent and detect crime, and enforce the
26	laws of this state.

Abstract: Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of unauthorized peace officer badges.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly or intentionally produce, manufacture, distribute, or possess unauthorized peace officer badges.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides penalties for possession of an unauthorized peace officer badge including a fine of not more than \$50, imprisonment for not more than 10 days, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the following penalties for distributing, manufacturing, or producing an unauthorized peace officer badge:

- (1) For a first conviction a fine of not more than \$200, imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both.
- (2) For a second or subsequent conviction a fine of not more than \$1,000, imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.

Provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall not be construed to limit the production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of a peace officer badge with the designation "police", "marshal", "sheriff", "law enforcement", "warden", or any other designation which does not designate a specific law enforcement agency by name or jurisdiction and which is intended for novelty purposes.

Provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall not be construed as granting the authority to any officer not defined as a "peace officer" pursuant to <u>present law</u> to make arrests, perform search and seizures, execute criminal warrants, prevent and detect crime, and enforce the laws of this state.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> <u>Justice to the original bill.</u>

- 1. Added exception for novelty badges which do not designate a specific law enforcement agency by name or jurisdiction.
- 2. Added attorney general investigators, district attorney investigators, and inspector general investigators to the definition of "peace officer".

House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill.

1. Added provision that <u>proposed law</u> does not grant authority to make arrests, perform search and seizures, execute criminal warrants, prevent and detect crime, and enforce law.
