Abstract: Repeals the three year prescription of penalties for suits by an official or agency responsible for the enforcement of a law or regulation governing the transportation and marketing of oil and gas.

<u>Present law</u> provides for suits by an official or agency responsible for the enforcement of a law, order, or regulation governing the production, transportation, and marketing of oil and gas by means of a money judgment or a forfeiture of property.

<u>Present law</u> provides that suits to enforce <u>present law</u> shall be instituted within three years after the violation shall have been made known to the attorney general.

Proposed law repeals present law.
