APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Jerry Powdrill, Amy Walker Landrum and Harry Walker, Individually and for the Estate of Glenda Powdrill v. State of La., DOTD"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-
3 2013 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Jerry Powdrill, Amy
4 Walker Landrum and Harry Walker, Individually and for the Estate of Glenda
5 Powdrill v. State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development"; and
6 to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Forty-One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Six
9 and 67/100 (\$141,666.67) Dollars in favor of Jerry Powdrill, the sum of One Hundred Forty-
10 One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Six and 66/100 (\$141,666.66) Dollars in favor of Amy
11 Walker Landrum, and the sum of the sum of One Hundred Forty-One Thousand Six
12 Hundred Sixty-Six and 66/100 (\$141,666.66) Dollars in favor of plaintiff, Harold Walker,
13 Jr., is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year
14 2012-2013 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Jerry Powdrill, Amy
15 Walker Landrum and Harry Walker, Individually and for the Estate of Glenda Powdrill v.
16 State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development", bearing Number
17 569809, Section 26, on the docket of the Nineteenth Judicial District Court, parish of East
18 Baton Rouge, state of Louisiana.

1 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the governor
2 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
3 2012, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
