WILDLIFE/FEES: Repeals the Wild Louisiana Stamp

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 56:10(B)(6)(a), 109(D)(1) through (4), 641(A), and 642(A) and
3	(B) and to repeal R.S. 56:1832 and 1833, relative to the Wild Louisiana Stamp; to
4	repeal the requirement for purchase of the stamp; to repeal references to the stamp;
5	and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 56:10(B)(6)(a), 109(D)(1) through (4), 641(A), and 642(A) and (B)
8	are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§10. Annual report to governor; estimate of proposed expenditures; particular funds;
0	warrants; vouchers; surplus funds

14	(6)(a) There is hereby created within the Conservation Fund a special
15	account known as the "natural heritage account" which shall consist of those
16	revenues collected from the sale of "Wild Louisiana" stamps and prints provided for
17	in R.S. 56:1832 and those funds donated or allocated for the protection and
18	stewardship of Louisiana's wild lands and waters to support the functions of the
19	Louisiana Natural Heritage Program. The revenues shall be subject to the same
20	requirements as provided for other revenues placed in the Conservation Fund in

5	§109. Wildlife management areas; wildlife refuges; public hunting grounds and
6	recreation areas; notice; signs; disabled hunters

8	D.(1) On and after July 1, 1993, a Wild Louisiana Stamp, A hunting license,
9	or fishing license shall be required for use of department administered lands
10	including wildlife refuges and wildlife management and habitat conservation areas.
11	Persons under sixteen years of age and sixty years of age or older are exempt from
12	this requirement. Persons attending official functions of private, non-profit
13	nonprofit, and charitable organizations recognized as tax exempt under the
14	provisions of the U.S. <u>United States</u> Internal Revenue Code shall be exempt from
15	this requirement.
16	(2) Persons using department administered lands for commercial purposes
17	for which the department is paid a royalty or special fee, agents of the state on
18	official business, and persons or groups using department administered lands for
19	purposes other than fishing or hunting who receive, for good cause, a letter of permit
20	from the secretary specifically waiving the Wild Louisiana Stamp, requirement for
21	possession of a hunting license, shall be exempt.
22	(3) For an initial violation of failing to possess a Wild Louisiana Stamp,
23	fishing license, or hunting license while on department administered lands, as
24	required by this Subsection, the violator shall immediately obtain a required stamp

or license or be required to leave the department administered lands. In such

instance of an initial violation, the violator shall be given directions to the nearest

place where such stamp or license may be purchased. After the initial violation, any

subsequent offenses shall be class one violations as designated in R.S. 56:31. This

Paragraph shall not apply to violations of hunting or fishing without a license.

(4) The department shall prominently post and maintain at each entrance to those lands subject to this Subsection a sign stating that all visitors, except those exempt by law, must possess a Wild Louisiana Stamp, a hunting license, a fishing license, or a WMA hunting permit while on those lands.

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§641. Hunting, fishing licenses; Wild Louisiana Stamp; multi-year multiyear issuance; fees

A. The Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, through its secretary, may, in addition to the issuance of annual individual hunting and fishing licenses and in order to facilitate the distribution of sport hunting and fishing licenses as provided in this Chapter, provide for the issuance of hunting or fishing licenses, or the Wild Louisiana Stamp, on a three year three-year basis, exclusive of any other special licenses otherwise authorized by law. The license may be issued on an individual license basis or any license combination presently allowed by law. The fee for such multi-year multiyear hunting or fishing licenses, or the Wild Louisiana Stamp, issued shall be the same as the sum of the individual hunting or fishing license, or the Wild Louisiana Stamp, or the sum of any combination hunting or fishing license as now or hereafter provided by law multiplied by three. The department shall provide for computerized mail renewal of all licenses or stamps issued under the provisions of this Section. The secretary shall promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the provisions of this Section.

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§642. Credit card or business check purchases

A. The department shall adopt rules for the purchase by credit card of hunting, recreational fishing, and recreational gear licenses, the duck license provided for in R.S. 56:152, and the combination or universal license provided for in R.S. 56:646, and the Wild Louisiana Stamp provided for in R.S. 56:1832. The rules shall include the criteria the purchaser and the credit card must meet in order to qualify for use.

1 B. The department may make available a "900" telephone number that any 2 purchaser may call in order to purchase such licenses by use of a credit card. The 3 department may, by rule, impose an additional fee for the use of a credit card to 4 purchase the licenses, provided that such fee shall not exceed the actual cost incurred by the department for providing for credit card transactions. The department shall 5 adopt a procedure to expedite the issuance of such licenses and stamps purchased by 6 7 telephone with a credit card. 8 9 Section 2. R.S. 56:1832 and 1833 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Henry Burns HB No. 290

Abstract: Repeals the requirement for purchase of a Wild Louisiana stamp for people engaged in activities other than hunting or fishing on the wildlife management areas of the state.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Wild Louisiana Stamp, as an alternative to a hunting or fishing license, to be issued to persons wanting to use department administered lands for purposes other than hunting or fishing.

Proposed law repeals the Wild Louisiana Stamp.
