2	To amend and reenact R.S. 44:4.1(B)(33) and to enact R.S. 56:6(34) and 433.1(A)(4),
3	relative to the powers and authority of the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission; to
4	authorize the commission to regulate and permit the taking of certain species of fish;
5	to authorize the commission to require the use of vessel monitoring systems on
6	vessels engaged in commercial harvest from the public oyster seed grounds; and to
7	provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 44:4.1(B)(33) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§4.1. Exceptions

12	B. The legislature further recognizes that there exist exceptions, exemptions,
13	and limitations to the laws pertaining to public records throughout the revised
14	statutes and codes of this state. Therefore, the following exceptions, exemptions, and
15	limitations are hereby continued in effect by incorporation into this Chapter by

6	procedures, landing requirements, tagging requirements, and other rules and

14	(4) In an effort to collect data to enable the department to better manage the
15	public oyster resource, the commission may adopt rules and regulations which
16	require the use of a vessel monitoring system for use by a vessel taking oysters for
17	commercial purposes under the authority of the oyster seed ground vessel permit.
18	Any data collected by the department shall be confidential and shall not be subject
19	to the Public Records Law.
