1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 46:2751(B)(1) and to enact R.S. 46:2751(B)(3), relative to the
3 Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission; to provide with respect
4 to the composition of the commission; to provide for the chairmanship of the
5 commission; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 46:2751(B)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
8 46:2751(B)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §2751. Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission; creation;
10 composition; duties

12 B.(1) The commission shall be composed as follows:

13 (a) ~~The lieutenant governor~~ The chief justice of the supreme court or an
14 associate justice of the supreme court appointed by the chief justice of the state
15 supreme court.

16 (b) One senator appointed by the president of the Senate.

17 (c) ~~A supreme court justice appointed by the chief justice of the state~~
18 ~~supreme court.~~

19 (d)(c) The commissioner of administration.

20 (e)(d) The vice president for Administration and Management, Southern
21 University and A&M College or his designee.

22 (f)(e) One representative appointed by the speaker of the House.

23 (f) One representative appointed by the Louisiana District Attorneys
24 Association.

1 (g) One representative appointed by the state public defender.

2 * * *

3 (3) Beginning on August 15, 2010, the representative appointed by the
4 speaker of the House of Representatives shall serve as the chairperson of the
5 commission for a period of one year. Beginning on August 15, 2011, the senator
6 appointed by the president of the Senate shall serve as the chairperson of the
7 commission for a period of one year. Each year thereafter, the House and Senate
8 member shall rotate serving as chairperson for a one-year term each.
