2	To enact R.S. 26:792(4), relative to the powers of the commissioner of the office of alcohol
3	and tobacco control; to provide that the commissioner shall have the authority to
4	investigate and enforce provisions of alcohol and tobacco control law against
5	unlicensed persons who are engaging in activity which requires the issuance of a
6	permit; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 26:792(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§792. Powers and duties
10	The commissioner shall have all of the powers and authorities provided in
11	this Title in relation to:
12	* * *
13	(4) Investigating and enforcing the provisions of this Title against unlicensed
14	persons engaged in activities which require a permit pursuant to this Title.

Abstract: Adds to the powers and duties of the commissioner in relation to the investigation and enforcement of provisions of alcohol and tobacco control law to unlicensed persons engaged in activities requiring a permit.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the powers and duties of the commissioner of the office of alcohol and tobacco control.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that the commissioner shall have the authority to investigate and enforce provisions of alcohol and tobacco control law contained in <u>present</u> <u>law</u> against unlicensed persons who are engaged in activities which require the issuance of a permit.
