TRANSPORTATION: Requires offshore oil rig personnel transporters to provide flotation devices equipped with personal locator beacons

2 To enact Part VIII of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be 3 comprised of R.S. 40:1486.1 and 1486.2, relative to safe transportation of offshore 4 oil platform workers; to provide for purpose; to provide for flotation devices to be 5 equipped with personal locator beacons; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. Purpose 12 The legislature finds that the production of oil for the energy needs of the 13 state and the nation is of vital concern and the safety of those who work in the 14 offshore industry and those who transport those workers is also of vital concern; 15 therefore, the legislature imposes certain requirements upon the transportation of 16 offshore workers. 17 §1486.2. Life preserver, life jacket, or life belt; personal locator beacon; required 18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any aircraft utilized to transport offshore platform workers, to and from the platform, shall 19 provide and carry, so placed as to be readily accessible, at least one life preserver, 20

Abstract: Requires transporters of offshore oil platform workers to provide, for each person on board, a life preserver, life jacket, or life belt and a personal locator beacon.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the production of oil is vital to the energy needs of the state and of the nation. Also provides that the safety of those who work in the offshore industry and those who transport such workers is of vital concern.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires any aircraft used in the transport of offshore platform workers to provide, for each person on board, a life preserver, life jacket, or life belt and a personal locator beacon. Provides that the device must be capable of transmitting a digital coded distress signal and a permanent homing signal. Also provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall be known as "Jacob's Law".
