2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:90(C) and 90.3(F) and to repeal R.S. 14:90(D) and (E),
3	relative to gambling; to provide technical corrections for certain exceptions to the
4	crimes of gambling and gambling by computer; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:90(C) and 90.3(F) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	§90. Gambling
9	* * *
10	C. The conducting or assisting in the conducting of authorized lottery
11	activities or operations in accordance with provisions of R.S. 47:9000 through 9081
12	shall not be considered gambling for purposes of this Section.
13	D. The intentional conducting or assisting in the conducting of gaming
14	activities or operations upon a riverboat as defined and authorized in R.S. 4:501
15	through R.S. 4:562, whereby a person risks the loss of anything of value in order to
16	realize a profit at the official gaming establishment, by operating an electronic video
17	draw poker device, by a charitable gaming licensee, or at a pari-mutuel wagering
18	facility, conducting slot machine gaming at an eligible horse racing facility, or the
19	operation of a state lottery which is licensed for operation and regulated under the
20	provisions of Chapters 4 and 11 of Title 4, Chapters 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Title 27, or
21	Subtitle XI of Title 47 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, is not gambling
22	and shall not be suppressed by any state or local law enforcement officer for the
23	purposes of this Section, so long as the wagering is done on the premises of the
24	licensed establishment.

3	F. The conducting or assisting in the conducting of gaming activities or
4	operations upon a riverboat, at the official gaming establishment, by operating an
5	electronic video draw poker device, by a charitable gaming licensee, or at a pari-
6	mutuel wagering facility, conducting slot machine gaming at an eligible horse racing
7	facility, or the operation of a state lottery which is licensed for operation and
8	regulated under the provisions of Chapter 4 Chapters 4 and 11 of Title 4, Chapters
9	4, 5, and 6, and 7 of Title 27, or Part V-A of Chapter 14 of Title 33 or Subtitle XI of
10	Title 47 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, shall not be considered gambling
11	by computer for the purposes of this Section, so long as the wagering is done on the
12	premises of the licensed establishment.

14	Section 2. R.S. 14:90(D) and (E) are hereby repealed in their entirety.
