STATE SYMBOL: Designates the pirogue as the official state vessel

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:170.17, relative to state symbols; to provide for the official state vessel;

3 and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 49:170.17 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 §170.17. State vessel

7 There shall be an official state vessel, which shall be the pirogue. The use

8 of its likeness or image on official documents of the state and with the insignia of the

9 state is hereby authorized.
